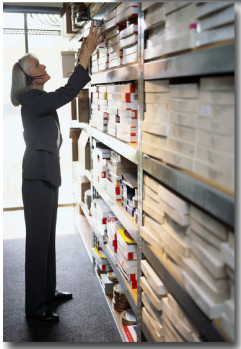
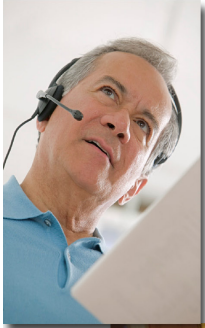


SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is the 'bridge' for older people to return to the competitive job market through on-the-job training in community service organizations. The SCSEP is funded by the U.S. Department of Labor under Title V of the Older Americans Act.

The program offers immediate training for 20 hours per week with a stipend of \$8.00 per hour during the training period. Enrollees are assigned to host agencies where they perform light duties such as clerical, filing, employment outreach, social service, and servicing in senior multipurpose programs.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

To qualify in the Title V program administered by the Department on Aging, State of Illinois, an applicant must:

- Be 55 years or older
- Be a member of a family which receives limited income
- Meet federal low-income guidelines

Fringe benefits during the training period are

- Paid time off
- Paid holidays

Upon successful completion of the training period, the Title V enrollees are placed into permanent, full- or part-time employment.
